15th July 1975 - 3rd January 2026

I think Terrie was empathic as she always came to the aid of others in need or in distress and knew what to do to make them feel better. Terrie thrived on being part of a community or a gang and just enjoyed life here at The Cart Shed. She loved life, loved people and animals and loved a simpler life away from London.
